First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34,39-40 Second Reading: Romans 8:14-77 Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20 The story is told of a priest sitting in an airport waiting for his flight to be announced. A fellow passenger next to him struck up a conversation. Said he, "Father, I believe only what I can understand. So, I can't buy your Trinity. Perhaps you can explain it to me."
