SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIMES (B) 28th July 2024

First Reading: 2 Kings 4:42-44 Second Reading: Ephesians 4:1-6 Gospel: John 6:1-15

The lectionary Gospel readings from Mark are replaced over the next five Sundays as the Church puts before us the entire sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. This chapter offers a lengthy meditation on the identity of Jesus as the Bread of Life and follows on from a telling of the story of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. This incident from the ministry of Jesus is the only one that John shares with Matthew, Mark and Luke.

What small offering do I have that the Lord may use to feed the world and the Church as we continue the journey through salvation history to the eternal banquet? In the gospel, the offering of the small boy was pivotal-the master knew it was therethe small boy made it available.

In John's version of the feeding of the five thousand, Jesus performs this great miracle and it is the sign the crowds were waiting for. There is a lot of rich symbolism in this passage referring to Jesus as the Bread of Life, the one who will satisfy people's hunger, the great teacher. But perhaps the final lines tells us a lot about the type of 'king' Jesus really is.

The crowds are so enthused by Jesus' miracles and teaching that they want to 'take him by force and make him king'. Jesus tries to dis courage them from their own ideas of kingship. His kingship involves a different path to the one the crowd are expecting. Jesus is cautious and to escape the attention, perhaps to be alone and pray, he takes himself out of this situation and retreats to the mountain. It could be tempting to give in to the crowd and have them declare you as their king.

Jesus' example of leadership is service in today's gospel, feeding the people, nourishing the people, meeting their needs. It also shows us how God can work with what we have to offer, no matter how little that sometimes is, he can turn this into much fruit.
